## **COLLEGE COLOURS POLICY**

- 1. College colours are awarded to students who qualify by satisfying the criteria set out in this document and who carry themselves in a manner that is exemplary in and around the College. They have to demonstrate a pride in the College, its uniform and regulations including good standing status for attendance and participation. The final decision is made by the Colours committee comprising of the referees for each category, chaired by the Dean of Secondary.
- 2. All College colours for years 7 to 11 are awarded at the end of the year's final awards assembly. Year 12 colours are awarded at the year 12 Graduation Ceremony.
- 3. Application forms can be accessed <u>here</u> and need to be completed by week 3 of term 4 for years 7 to 11 and by week 7 of term 3 for year 12 students.
- 4. Referees of each area take their nominations to the Colours committee for a final decision in Week 7 of the respective terms.
- 5. Students receiving colours will be informed of the date on which they will be awarded College colours, and students who are unsuccessful in their application will receive feedback from their respective referees.

#### INDEX FOR CRITERIA OF CATEGORIES COVERED BY THIS POLICY:

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## Academic Colours: Coordinator: Associate Dean of Secondary

Academic Colours and half colours are awarded at the end of each academic year: at the final Year 7-11 Awards assembly and the Year 12 graduation ceremony.

Award	Criteria
Academic Half Colours	Students in Years 7-10 who have achieved an "A" grade in the top class for English, Maths, Science & HASS, and an "A" grade average across all subjects.
	Students in Year 11 and Year 12 who have achieved an "A" grade average across a minimum of five ATAR courses.
Academic Full Colours	Students in Years 7-10 who have achieved "A" grades across all subjects (with an academic component), and are in the top classes for English, Maths, Science & HASS. Students in Year 11 and Year 12 who have achieved "A" grades across all subjects with a minimum of five ATAR courses
Note: "A" Grade average i "A" grade – 4 point "B" grade – 3 point "C" grade – 2 point	S

"C" grade – 2 points

"D" grade – 1 point

Points are then aggregated and averaged, and an average of 3.5 or higher is considered an "A" grade average.

This would then include examples such as

- i) 3 "A"s and 1"C"
- ii) 2 "A"s and 2 "B"s
